A case is closed upon revocation when a judge, parole commission, or other judicial authority finds the defendant violated one or more of conditions imposed as part of the supervision term and that termination of the supervision term is warranted pursuant to applicable federal statutes, U.S. Sentencing Commission Policy Statements, the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, and various other administrative rules. Re-sentencing upon revocation may, but does not necessarily, result in a term of imprisonment
