

NOTE: An "October term" is the term of the Supreme Court of the United States, which by statute begins on the first Monday in October and ends in late June or early July of the following year. The date associated with each October term is the year in which the term began (in most other tables of the federal Judiciary, the date associated with each reporting period is the year in which that period ended). This report is furnished by the Supreme Court of the United States. This table presents data on cases filed in prior terms as well as cases docketed during the current term. The data in this table is not identical to the data reported in the Chief Justice's Year-End Reports on the Federal Judiciary.
